PRE-ACTUARIAL SCIENCE MAJOR, B.S. - 2023-2024

To be admitted to the full major, students must complete all pre-major courses with a 2.5 or higher UC grade-point average. All pre-major courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Students are permitted to repeat a maximum of two pre-major courses. Only one repeat is allowed in each course. In the case of a letter grade below C, students must repeat the course at UCSB. Preparation courses are excluded from the pre-major GPA, but will apply to the overall major GPA. Students must complete Computer Science 8 and either 9 or 16 with a grade of "C" or better. Entry into the pre-major does not guarantee admission to full major status. While completing required preparation, students are classified as a Pre-Actuarial Science major.

*Note: - Either Math 4A, 4B, 6A, or 6B must be completed with a grade of "B" or better in order to take Math 8 or PSTAT 8.
- Math 8 is a prerequisite for all upper division Math courses except Math 117, 104A, 104B, and 104C. If
you plan to take additional upper division Math courses, you must take Math 8.

PREPARATION FOR THE MAJOR

Note: CMPSC 9 is recommended over CMPSC 16. Also, students cannot get credit for CMPSC 8 at UCSB if transferring in credit for CMPSC 9 or 16, so please see the Department advisors in such instances.

Recommended courses: Econ 1, 2, 3A, 10A (fulfills VEE), and Phil 3 or 4.

Note: Math 100A-B, 101A-B, 102A-B, 193; PSTAT 109, 182T (or W 182T), 193 will NOT apply to the major.

Upon satisfactory completion of the pre-major requirements, the student must complete a change of major petition in the Department of Statistics and Applied Probability, 5607A South Hall, and obtain the appropriate signatures. At that time, the student must declare the specific major option of Statistics and Data Science (B.A. or B.S.) or Actuarial Science (B.S.).
